Safe Start Guidelines for the 2021/2022 Academic Year

The health and safety of our students and families is a priority at Redeemer. The following general guidelines were adopted for the 2020/2021 academic year and will remain in place until recommendations from WSDH and the CDC are changed.

Redeemer will hold in-person learning (school at school) unless a positive case of COVID-19 is reported in a classroom at which time that class will seamlessly switch to school at home learning for the duration of quarantine. Lessons will be prepped and delivered to your home to promote continuous learning.

Enforcing social distancing in the early childhood classroom is not a realistic option. We will do our best to keep space between the children and classes will operate as independent learning cohorts. Students will participate in both indoor and outdoor recess.

Face coverings are required to enter the building. Parents are asked to wear a face covering during school arrival and dismissal times. Staff will wear a face shield during instruction and a face mask when prepping materials. Face coverings are not required for children of this age but are an option.

Every student will participate in a COVID-19 screening (temp. & questions) before entering the classroom. Parents/guardians are asked to pre-screen before coming to school each day. Children who have a fever of 100.4 degrees or above or other signs of COVID illness or exposure will not be allowed to attend that day.

Classrooms, toys, supplies, recess equipment and restrooms will be cleaned and disinfected every day. Children will be encouraged to wash hands frequently and hand sanitizer is available for use.
